

Core Functions:


- 1. Supporting market operators ability to do their work more effectively



Equipment Status by State






Nutrition Hub

Listing of States with EBT Machine Contracts

- <u>18 state contracts</u> include a no-cost, wireless provision and will require no federal subsidy
- <u>28 states</u> could take advantage of a limited-time, 100 percent federal funding option for EBT-only equipment and service
